Graduate Certificates

AG*IDEA and GPIDEA Graduate Certificates and their affiliated courses. All courses (even those offered by other AG*IDEA member institutions) that are approved by the CASNR Curriculum Committee and Graduate Council and listed in the Graduate Bulletin

Enrollment process for UNL graduate students admitted into an AG*IDEA or GPIDEA certificate¹ – Enroll for courses affiliated with the AG*IDEA or GPIDEA programs by contacting the CASNR Online Student Services Specialist.

Enrollment process for UNL students not pursuing an AG*IDEA or GPIDEA certificate, but wishing to take courses that are part of a certificate program¹ – If the course is taught by a UNL faculty member, students must enroll through the MyRed System for the face-to-face (section number – 00X or 1XX) or online (section number – 700 or 900) sections (Attachment 1)¹.

Graduate students enrolled in UNL degree programs are not permitted to take courses offered through Ag*IDEA or GPIDEA by other member institutions unless permission is granted from the CASNR Dean's Office. Please complete and submit the Permission Request Form for Enrolling in AG*IDEA/GPIDEA Courses (Attachment 2) to the CASNR Dean's Office. If granted permission, the CASNR Online Student Services Specialist will contact the student with enrollment details.

¹If on a graduate assistantship, AG*IDEA and GPIDEA courses taken as part of a graduate certificate through UNL may be eligible for tuition remission.

Course-Share Programs

(Undergraduate and Graduate)

Selected courses offered as a non-credentialed program from other AG*IDEA member institutions. Courses are approved by the CASNR Curriculum Committee and UNL Curriculum Committee and/or Graduate Council and listed in the Undergraduate Bulletin and/or Graduate Bulletin

Enrollment process for UNL students pursuing a degree in one of the following degree programs: Animal Science (BS, MS or PhD), Mechanized Systems Management (BS), Biological Systems Engineering (BS), or Agricultural Engineering (BS)² – If the course is taught by a UNL faculty member, students must enroll through the MyRed System for the face-to-face (section number – 00X or 1XX) or online (section number – 700 or 900) sections (Attachment 1).

Undergraduate and graduate students enrolled in UNL degree programs are not permitted to take courses offered through Ag*IDEA or GPIDEA by other member institutions unless permission is granted from the CASNR Dean's Office². Please complete and submit the Permission Request Form for Enrolling in AG*IDEA/GPIDEA Courses (Attachment 2) to the CASNR Dean's Office. If granted permission, the CASNR Online Student Services Specialist will contact the student with enrollment details.

²If on a graduate assistantship, AG*IDEA and GPIDEA courses taken as part of a course-share program through UNL may be eligible for tuition remission.

Undergraduate tuition associated with an AG*IDEA course-share program offered through UNL may be covered by scholarships and financial aid.

Individual Course-Share

(Undergraduate and Graduate)

Our agreement with Online Worldwide precludes us from providing any UNL courses as part of an AG*IDEA/GPIDEA course-share. Students from the other AG*IDEA/GPIDEA institutions can access our undergraduate and graduate courses through Online Worldwide. If a UNL student and their advisor identifies a course offered through the AG*IDEA/GPIDEA course-share from another member institutions that would enhance their educational experience and an equivalent course is not offered through the NU System, the student can submit the Permission Request Form for Enrolling in AG*IDEA/GPIDEA Courses (Attachment 2) to the CASNR Dean's Office³. If granted permission, the CASNR Online Student Services Specialist will contact the student with enrollment details.
